



Lake Roland Boating Regulations

1. Boating allowed only during park hours. Boat at your own risk.
2. Only car top watercraft are allowed. Boats are limited to a maximum length of 20 feet and a maximum width of 42 inches.
3. All boats must be launched at the designated launch area adjacent to the Lakeside Drive parking lot. No boat landing allowed between the launch area and the dam, anywhere on the Paw Point peninsula, or on the Light Rail causeway.
4. Only human powered boats are allowed. No motor or sail of any type is permitted.
5. Inflatable boats must have a minimum of three independent air chambers.
6. No swimming or wading.
7. Everyone must wear a lifejacket (PFD) at all times while on the water.
8. All children in boats who are 17 years of age or younger must be supervised by a parent or responsible adult at all times. The adult must also be in a boat. The supervising adult is fully responsible for the children's actions.
9. No boat is allowed closer to the dam than the warning buoys.
10. No boat is allowed closer to the Paw Point Dog Park than the warning buoys.
11. When paddling on days where the water temperature is below 60 degrees Fahrenheit, a wetsuit or drysuit is required.
12. No Remote Control Powerboats are allowed. RC Sailboats not exceeding 60 inches in length are allowed. RC Sailboats must observe the same operating restrictions as human powered boats.
