



Professional Photography Regulations

Professional photography sessions cannot be conducted at Lake Roland without a permit (Baltimore County Recreation & Parks Directive A-13). All requests for permits must be reviewed by the Director of Recreation and Parks or their designee and be accompanied by a letter detailing the activity, justification of the need for this particular site and a projected income statement. All commercial vendors must provide insurance in compliance with Baltimore County standards. All Professional Photographers **MUST** have a comprehensive general liability insurance policy for combined bodily injury and property damage with a minimum policy limit of \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence and \$2,000,000.00 in the aggregate, and shall name the parks owner as an additional insured on the policy as follows: Baltimore County, 2nd Floor 400 Washington Avenue, Towson, MD 21204 and the Lake Roland Nature Council, 1000 Lakeside Drive, Baltimore, MD 21210. A copy of the above insurance certificate **MUST** be sent to the Lake Roland Nature Center, 1000 Lakeside Drive, Baltimore, MD 21210 or via email to both lakeroland@lakeroland.org and lakerol-rp@baltimorecountymd.gov.
