

City Authorizes Sale Of Lake Roland Span

The Board of Estimates yesterday authorized A. L. Dell, deputy comptroller, to sell an old city bridge to a dealer so it can be dismantled and the scrap used for war purposes. The request to sell the bridge was made by the War Production Board. According to Mr. Dell, the bridge will yield about thirty tons of scrap.

The structure is located on city property and crosses Jones' Falls at a point about 200 feet west of the Lake Roland dam and approximately fifty feet east of the intersection of Hollins avenue and Lakewood avenue in Baltimore county.

Mr. Dell said it will be sold to Edward L. Blum, trading as the Baltimore Salvage Company, for \$50.
