

## **\$536,696 Sewer Job Is Started**

Work has started on a Baltimore county sanitation project in which a 42-inch pipe sewer will be put under **Lake Roland** and the Northern Central Railroad tracks.

This sewer, costing \$536,696 and requiring about two years to build, will start at the county line and Jones Falls, near Mount Washington, and follow Jones Falls to the Northern Central Railroad tracks, beneath which it will be channeled for 900 feet.

From there it will go under **Lake Roland** to the head of the lake, follow along the stream through Ruxton and Riderwood to a treatment plant that exists in southwest Lutherville.
