Register now for 2022 Summer Nature Camp!



Current and new members of the Lake Roland Nature Council are eligible for early registration on April 11, 2022. Registrations will be accepted in person and via mail. General public registration opens on April 18, 2022. **E-mailed applications are not accepted. Walk up registrations will be a priority.**

To register, mail or bring this completed form along with your payment by check, cash, or money order to: Lake Roland Nature Center 1000 Lakeside Drive, Baltimore, MD 21210. Registrations not accompanied by payment will not be accepted.

Registration confirmation will occur via email. You will receive a welcome letter and health form to complete. Health forms must be returned in 7 days. If health forms are not received on time, your spot will be forfeited and filled from the waitlist.

Please use one registration form per child. No out of state campers will be accepted.

Before and after camp care is not provided. Campers must arrive and depart at the designated time. Should you arrive late to camp, we cannot guarantee that we will be able to accept your child on that day. A fee of \$1/minute will be incurred for late pick-ups.

If a camper requires special accommodations, please contact the nature center at least one month prior to the start of camp to discuss their needs.

Cancellation and Refund policy: There will be no refunds due to cancellations, closures, or illness. Be advised Due to the nature of covid-19, if you have any concerns with having your child attend camp, it is recommended you consult with your health care provider first.

All Lake Roland memberships and Camp fees are considered donations to the Lake Roland Nature Council. Lake Roland Nature Council will not be providing camp refunds under any circumstances.

Lake Roland Summer Camps will be following guidelines based off of CDC, MDDH, BCHD, and Baltimore County Recreation and Parks department guidelines. These guidelines may change at any time.

The Lake Roland Nature Camp will implement appropriate social distancing protocols and best practice cleaning procedures. Including requiring all campers to wear face coverings when social distancing cannot take place. Parents are required to do daily health checks before they arrive at camp. If the camper is sick they need to stay home. Temperature checks will be taken at check in. If over 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit, the camper cannot attend camp for the day. Virtual video content will be provided to any camper who cannot return to camp or who is in Covid quarantine or due to illness.

Any updates to regulations for operating a social distanced youth summer camp in Baltimore County will be provided prior to the camp start date. **Covid-19 Waivers will be required for every camper.**

Due to Covid-19 the number of campers accepted will be limited. We ask families to choose only **one week** of camp so that more children have the opportunity to have a camp experience this summer. A waitlist for a second week of camp will be accepted, however it is not guaranteed.

Camp will be held outside in a pavilion. For severe weather conditions, campers will be moved inside the nature center.

In order to properly keep camp safely operating every day, camp counselors have a zero tolerance policy for improper use of masks, social distancing, and following of all other safety instructions made by staff.
