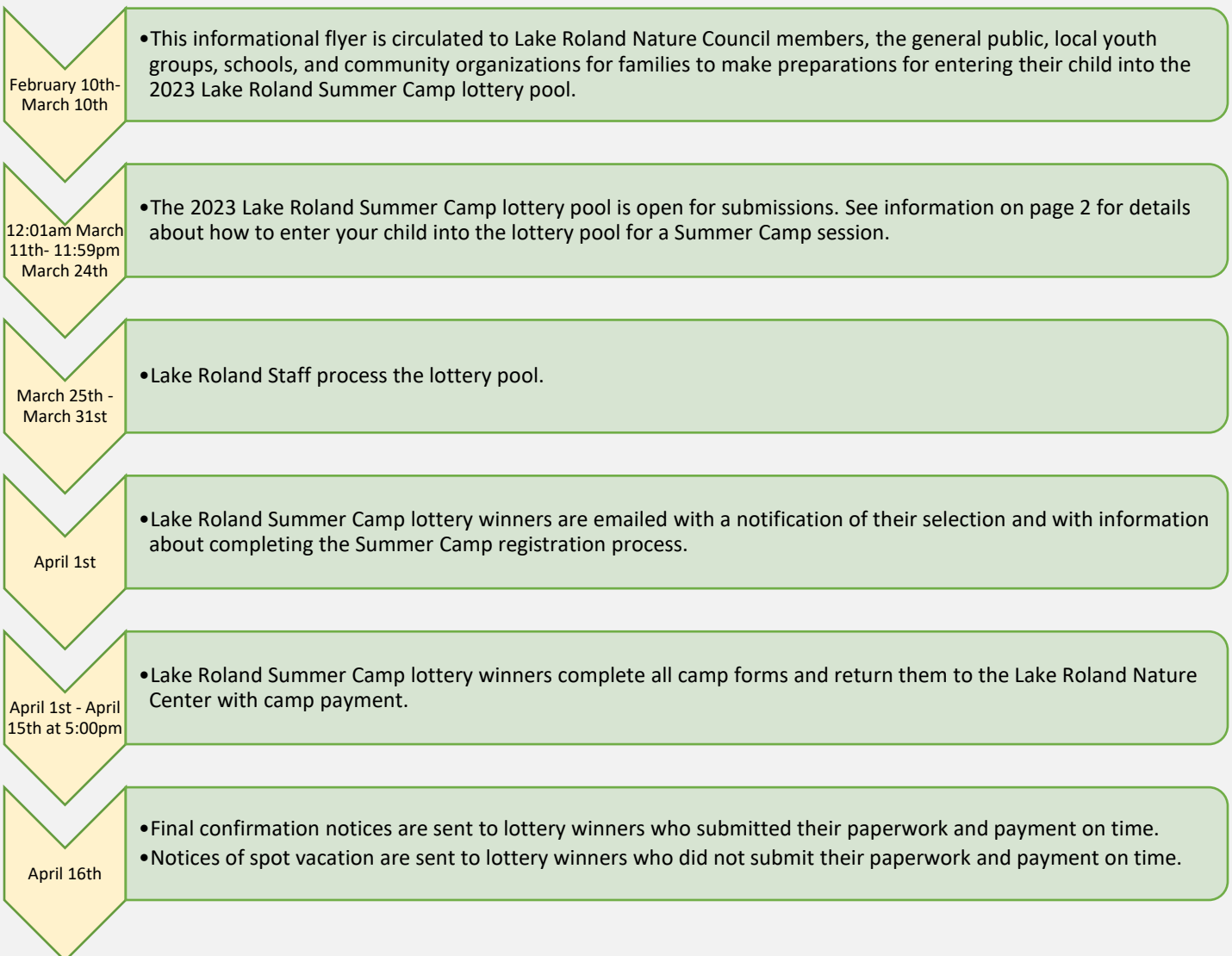

Lake Roland's Summer Camp Lottery opens for submissions on March 11th at 12:01 am

Once the lottery opens, Parents and Guardians enter their child's name into the lottery by emailing Lake Roland Staff at: lakerol-rp@baltimorecountymd.gov , providing the following information:

- Name of Parent or Guardian
- Parent or Guardian's email address
- Parent or Guardian's phone number
- Name of the prospective Camper or Campers
- Age and Birthdate of Camper or Campers
- Which week of camp the prospective Camper or Campers want to be entered into the lottery for
- Whether or not your Camper would attend the alternate week of Summer Camp for your child's age range if you weren't selected for your preferred week
- Whether or not you are a member of the Lake Roland Nature Council

Lottery Process Details:

- Parents and Guardians can expect to receive notice via email on **April 1st** as to whether or not their camper has been accepted into a Lake Roland Summer Camp session. At that point, Lake Roland Staff will provide further instructions about completing camp registration.
- Campers cannot register for multiple camp sessions unless spots are still vacant after the lottery has been fully exhausted.
- Multiple Campers cannot enter themselves into the lottery together (with the exception of siblings who will both be reserved a spot should one of their names be drawn from the lottery pool).
- Lottery selections will be made in two rounds; the first round of selections will be pulled from Lake Roland Nature Council members and the second round of selections will be pulled from the general public.
- Lottery winners who do not submit all the required paperwork and payment by **April 15th at 5:00pm** will forfeit their spot in the Summer Camp session and a new lottery winner will be selected.

General Camp Information:

- Cancellation and Refund policy: There will be no refunds due to cancellations, closures, or illness. Be advised Due to the nature of covid-19, if you have any concerns with having your child attend camp, it is recommended you consult with your health care provider first.
- All Lake Roland memberships and Camp fees are considered donations to the Lake Roland Nature Council. Lake Roland Nature Council will not be providing camp refunds under any circumstances.
- Lake Roland Summer Camps will be following guidelines based off of CDC, MDDH, BCHD, and Baltimore County Recreation and Parks department guidelines. These guidelines may change at any time.
- Camp will largely be held outside. Under severe weather conditions, campers will be moved inside the Nature Center.
- In order to properly keep camp safely operating every day, camp counselors have a zero tolerance policy for campers disregarding safety and hygiene guidance made by staff.
